1) 1st Meeting in Singapore in August, 2011

Day 1	Arrival, Orientation, Self-introduction
Day 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ice-breaking games - Introducing case study of Expo 2005 Aichi Japan - Environmental workshops - Sharing environmental issues among participants and presenting their own plan. Based on their own country's environmental issues, participants are going to present the plan that includes how he/she wants to solve the problem.
Day 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discussion for selecting the action plan and conducting its plan. From several plans that are raised by participants, one action plan in each country will be selected. Furthermore, all the participant discuss the topic "what is necessary for conducting the plan?". - Deciding the next section meeting and division of roles. Conducting the division of roles for works on September to December. Participants have to attend to either "Network building program", "Publishing program" or "Country program".
Day 4	- On-site study tour (day trip) Conducting an on-site training which can directly learn the environmental issues in Singapore.
Day 5	- Wrap up, Farewell
